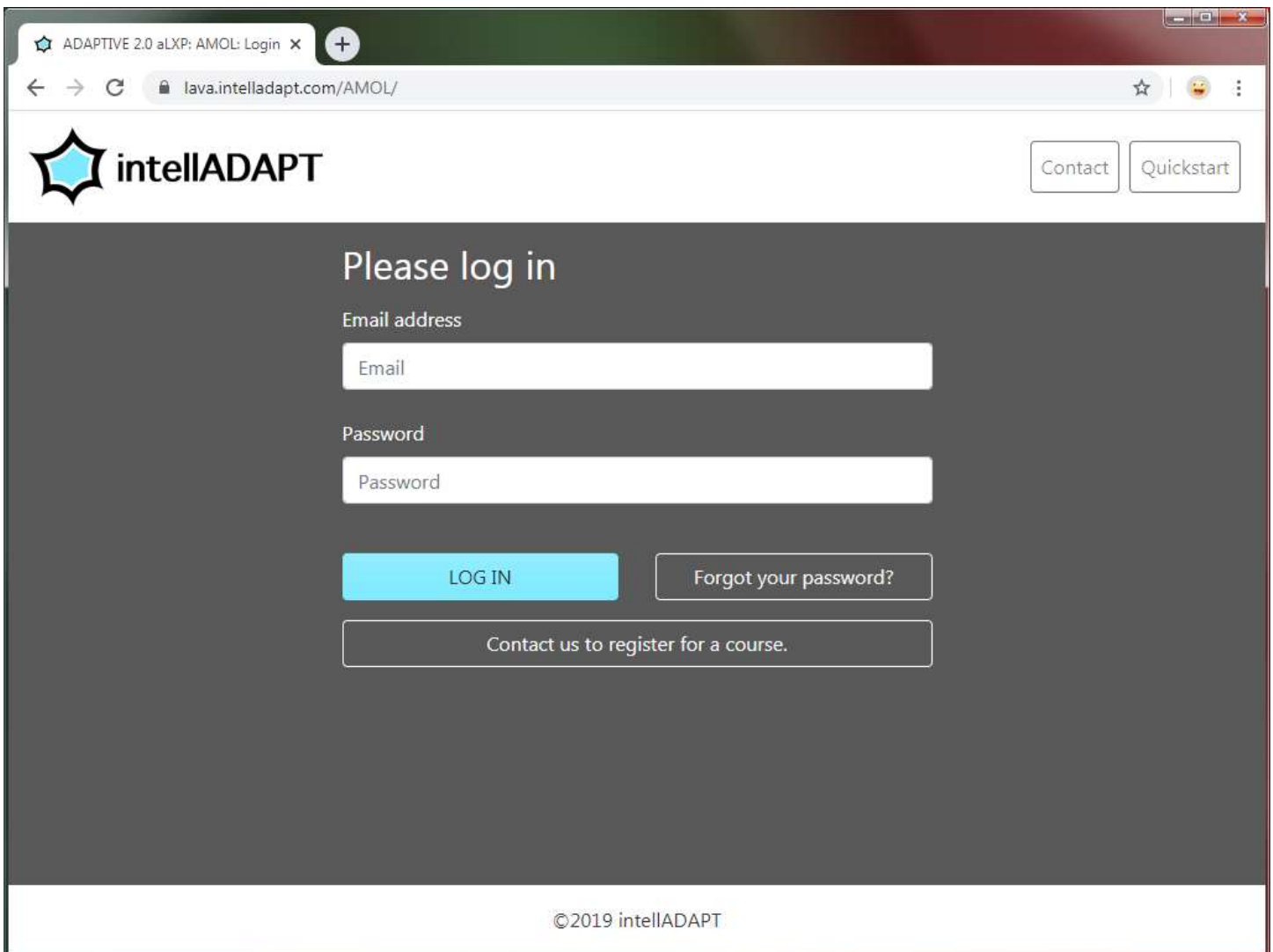

# Quick Start Guide

This Quick Start Guide explains how to get into your account, set up your profile, navigate the intellADAPT website, get around your course and keep track of your progress.


## Sign In

The first step is to log-in to the intellADAPT website at with your username and password.



## Changing Your Profile and Password

Once you have logged in, the page you are on is called the **Welcome Page**. You can use the drop-down menu with your name on it in the upper navigation bar to get to your **Profile** page and to **Logout** of the website.





## Accessing Your Course


On the **Dashboard** page select your course to begin. Selecting the name of a course takes you to that course's content.
